AND WHEREAS the Government desires to pay the said sum to the claimant but under Government rules and orders it is necessary that the claimant should first execute a bond with two sureties to indemnify Government against all claims to the amount so due as aforesaid to the said (d) _____ before the said sum can be paid the claimant;

NOW THE CONDITION of this bond is such that if after payment has been made to the claimant, the claimant or the sureties shall in the event of a claim, being made by any other person against Government with respect of the aforesaid sum of ` (in words Rupees.) refund to Government the sum of ` (in words Rupees.) and shall otherwise indemnify and have Government harmless from all liability in respect of the aforesaid sum and all cost incurred in consequence of; claim there to then the above written bond or obligation shall be void but otherwise the same shall remain in full force and virtue;
